## **Award Ribbons Display Guide:**

- On a uniform award ribbons shall be worn horizontally, centered above an employee's left shirt pocket on their uniform shirt.
- Ribbons are worn in rows of three (3), with the highest award closest to the wearer's heart.
- When an odd number of ribbons are worn, the highest award shall be displayed on the top row and centered.
- The following list shows the order of precedence for each award as it is displayed on the uniform:

1.	Medal of Valor Ribbon.	
2.	Commissioner's Award Ribbon.	
3.	Lifesaving Award Ribbon.	
4.	Officer of the Year Ribbon.	
5.	Field Training Officer (FTO) Ribbon.	
6.	Firearms Instructor (FI) Ribbon.	
7.	Prisoner Transport Officer (PTO) Ribbon.	
8.	Special Operations Response Team (SORT) Ribbon.	
9.	K–9 Handler Ribbon.
