PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Interim Policy And Procedures Memorandum (IPPM) is to place language into existing policy requiring housing considerations for prisoners at risk of sexual victimization. Specifically with the goal of keeping separate those prisoners at high risk of being sexually victimized from those at high risk of being sexually abusive.

APPLICATION:

This IPPM applies to all Department employees and prisoners.

EXISTING DOC POLICY & PROCEDURES MODIFIED:

This IPPM modifies language found in DOC P&P 808.09, Prisoner Housing. Specifically language found in Procedures section VII, (C), improperly annotated as Section VI, (C).

NEW PROCEDURES:

- I. The results of DOC form 809.19A, *PREA Risk Assessment* shall be utilized in housing considerations. Prisoners who score as a Potential Aggressor shall not be housed with prisoners who score as a Potential Victim. Prisoners who score as a Potential Victim shall not be housed with prisoners who score as a Potential Aggressor. However, prisoners who do not score as a Potential Aggressor or Potential Victim may be housed with a Potential Aggressor or a Potential Victim.
