The meeting was called to order on Tuesday November 13, 2015, at approximately 9:02 a.m. in 18th floor Department of Correction's conference room Atwood Building, Anchorage, Alaska.

- 1) At the last meeting the committee reviewed an application from Doctor Catherine Rutherford and had some questions. Therefore, she made herself available telephonically on this date to answer all questions. Her application was reviewed with Doctor Rutherford on the telephone. Several clarifications were asked of her and she was excused. A vote was taken and she was unanimously approved as a Level II Approved Provider. She will have to get supervision for at least the first year of any work done for DOC.
- 2) The next item was Jo Romine's request to move from a Level II provider to a Level I provider. A progress report was reviewed written by her current supervisor, Doctor Lazur. Ms. Romine scored 5 out of 5 on every category and Doctor Lazur recommended that Ms. Romine be approved for Level I status. A vote was taken and Ms. Romine was approved to progress to Level I approved provider.
- 3) The last item on the agenda was a review for Marylee Cassell-Quinto's application to become an Approved Provider. The committee reviewed her application and a discussion was held. A vote was taken and Ms. Cassell-Quinto was unanimously approved as a Post Graduate Pre-Licensed Intern. Ms. Cassell-Quinto will need to gain her license in the State of Alaska but at this time she can assist while under the direct supervision of a Supervisor.
