	Chapter: Community Programs		Subject: Supervision of Offenders in Residential Treatment Programs

Policy

- A. The probation officer will develop and maintain a cooperative relationship with the residential treatment program staff to coordinate the offender’s supervision.
- B. The probation officer is the approving authority for any significant changes in the offender’s treatment plan.

Procedures

- A. Supervision Procedures. The supervision of offenders in residential treatment programs must be conducted as follows:
 - 1. Offenders residing in a residential treatment program must be directly supervised by the staff of the treatment programs; however, the ultimate authority for case decisions remains with the probation officer. The probation officer shall maintain contact with the staff of the treatment program to determine the offender’s progress in treatment and to coordinate the offender’s treatment plan.
 - 2. Offenders residing in a residential treatment program must be classified by the probation officer in accordance with Policy and Procedure 902.03, Classification and Supervision Standards. The probation officer shall supervise the offender based on the standard for supervision established for the offender’s supervision level.
