


POLICY:

It is the policy of the Department of Corrections (DOC), Division of Pretrial, Probation and Parole to have formalized set standards providing electronic monitoring services within a geographical location in which the electronic monitoring equipment is reliable, has a regional pretrial office and the regional pretrial office can respond in a reasonable amount of time to equipment needs and violations of court orders.

APPLICATION:

This policy and procedure shall apply to pretrial employees of the DOC Division of Pretrial, Probation and Parole. These procedures shall apply to defendants ordered to electronic monitoring as a condition of pretrial supervision.

PROCEDURES:

- I. Each regional pretrial office will establish a geographical area of electronic monitoring service based on equipment limitations and reasonable response published in a standard operation procedure (SOP) and provide it to the court and applicable counsel.
- II. In the event of a court order received directing release of a defendant requiring electronic monitoring in a geographical area not supported by a regional pretrial office:
 - A. Pretrial Services will immediately alert the District Attorney's Office, defense counsel, and the court of the inability to comply with the electronic monitoring of the court order and request the order be amended or changed.
